Expenses of the federal class action lawsuit

The following is a considered listing of all expected expenses involved for successfully prosecuting the federal class action lawsuit against the rogue Texas family court system, and **all** donations received go directly to one (1) or more of the following crucial needs:

Level One (1) = \$1500

=====

-- \$405 new fed case filing fee, \$300+ for formal process served upon all 3 Defendants on our event schedule, \$300 for 2X paid statewide media distributions of press releases via the Texas Press Association, also various printing, copying and postal expenses, envelopes, exhibit red ink stamp, etc., plus minor miscellaneous expenses if/as needed;

Level Two (2) = \$5000

=====

-- Noon downtown Austin presser event upon filing the new class action suit (at steps of the federal courthouse itself, or about one mile away at the TX Capitol or at the TX Supreme Court, permit fees if any to reserve whichever event location, 500+ hand signs pre-printed to hand out onsite and/or make sign available for on-demand purchase and shipping/delivery ahead of time, printed supply of pamphlets/brochures/handouts, PA equipment, tripods + video cameras, actual portable stage or use steps/sidewalk, etc.)

-- three major nationwide press release services (@ \$250-\$500 each, total \$1000 max)

-- distributions of gasoline monies to the 27 Divisional clusters of Texas counties for supporters to attend the Austin filing event

Level Three (3) = \$25K

=====

-- TexasPRA organization, network, setup, administration, domain, hosting, email, and miscellaneous related costs

-- much bigger distributions of gas monies to 27 Divisional clusters of Texas counties for supporters to attend the Austin filing event

-- reasonable pay to legal scholar team working behind the scenes to generate the most bulletproof, iron-clad class action case documents possible

-- possible large permitted rally at the State Capitol complex on official Parents' Day, Sunday, July 19th (on the day before Monday filing event at same general location)

-- Possible simultaneous rally events also on the steps of the federal courthouses in Ft. Worth, Dallas, Houston, San Antonio, El Paso, Lubbock, and other large TX metro areas on either/both official Parents' Day (Sun, July 19th) and/or the next day of filing the new class action (Mon, July 20th)

-- meals, travel, miscellaneous to recruit public support by Texas-resident celebrities screwed by family courts to also come attend/speak at the Austin filing rally event

Then later on, if even needed, another \$5K+ for any appeal, and \$5K+ to go to SCOTUS if actually necessary. But we are confident of big victory that will not even be appealed.
